What is the **Lutheran SeniorLife Foundation** and what does it do?





The Foundation is responsible for raising funds for all of the programs offered by **Lutheran SeniorLife**. This includes:

- Four LIFE Programs serving Armstrong, Beaver, Butler and Lawrence Counties
- Lutheran Service Society, which operates Meals on Wheels in Beaver County, two Senior Centers, an adoption agency and several affordable senior housing complexes
- Visiting Nurses Association of Western PA, which provides hospice and inpatient hospice services, palliative care, home health and private duty care
- Passavant and St. John Communities, residential campuses located in Zelienople and Mars, Pennsylvania

The Foundation raises money for:

- Specific projects and campaigns
- General purposes, including Benevolent Care and the Foundation Mission Fund

There are two categories of donations to the Foundation:

- Designated or restricted funds money that is given for a specific purpose and can only be used for that purpose
- Unrestricted funds gifts that are made directly to the Foundation or to a program or service, but are not for a specific purpose

Ways to help support the Foundation and Lutheran SeniorLife:

- Make donations through various appeals throughout the year
- Donate in honor or memory of someone
- Make a gift designated for a specific purpose or special project
- Establish a Charitable Gift Annuity, a larger donation that provides income for the rest of a person's life
- Make a direct rollover from an IRA as a distribution
- Make a regular, recurring gift
