Synod Council Recommendation 4 for Updating the SWPA Synod Constitution

GROUP A Changes to the Constitution

These changes require two affirmative votes at consecutive Synod Assemblies. This is the first reading and vote of these changes.

Constitution

(1) Create a section <u>S9.07. Election Procedures</u>

Rationale: This would be a place where bylaws on elections can be housed. They can live in S9.02, but would be better with its own section.

Create sections:

(2) S11.06. There shall be Standing Committees of the Synod. These committees shall be outlined in the Bylaws and Continuing Resolutions of the Synod. (Requires votes of two consecutive Synod Assemblies)

(3) <u>S11.07. The Synod Council shall form other committees to assist in the work and ministry of the Synod.</u> (Requires votes of two consecutive Synod Assemblies)

Rationale: This will clean up where the bylaws will live in section 11. There are three types of committees in our synod structure: Committees of the Synod (i.e. Executive, Discipline, etc), Standing Committees, and Committees of the Synod Council (i.e. Constitutions and Bylaws, Archives, Ecumenical Affairs, etc).
