Delegates must be present at all sessions and be seated for the beginning of the first business session. Any delegates not seated at the first business session will not be able to serve as a delegate at the other sessions. Inform the Registrar, Audrey Bisignani, of any delegate or alternate delegate changes prior to the start of the convention.

Nominating Ballot

Each year at convention, we have some women unfamiliar with the nominating ballot process. We use this means of selection for our president and vice-president. This eliminates "unintentional politics" and gives us a clear way for God to help us choose our next leader.

This is the way it works-on the first ballot you may write the name of anyone you feel is ready for the task of President or Vice-President. Every name on the first ballot is nominated for President or Vice-President. The second ballot is cast using only the names from the first ballot. Voting continues until someone emerges as the choice. No names can be added to the ballot after the first/nominating ballot. This year, we will be electing a President.
